Comments:

The above-mentioned documents were presented and discussed at the 6th Monitoring Committee meeting, held online on 2 July 2026.

The MC approved the proposed Programme modification in accordance with Article 19(5) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059. The reallocation aims to optimise the absorption and performance of the Programme by enabling the contracting of an additional project from the reserve list under Priority 4 (HR-RS00355 Danube Digital Outdoor). The transfer will contribute to the achievement of Programme output and result indicators, while ensuring the full utilisation of available Programme resources. The reduction of the allocation under Priority 3 will not adversely affect the achievement of its objectives, outputs and results, as all available projects have already been funded and no reserve list exists under this Priority.


The proposed transfer concerns EUR 520,001 of the EU contribution allocated to operations under Priority 3 (excluding Technical Assistance), while the corresponding Technical Assistance allocation amounting to EUR 52,000 of EU contribution is also reallocated.

Consequently, the total EU contribution allocated to Priority 3 is reduced by EUR 572,001 and the total EU contribution allocated to Priority 4 is increased by the same amount.

The proposed transfer represents approximately 7.5% of the initial EU allocation of Priority 3 and therefore remains below the threshold established in Article 19(5) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059.

The Monitoring Committee also approved the amended Monitoring Committee Rules of Procedure. The amendments aim to enable the current Monitoring Committee to perform the role of the Programming Task Force and to participate in the preparation of the future Interreg Croatia–Serbia Programme for the 2028–2034 programming period, ensuring continuity of experience, know-how and partnership involvement. The specific tasks and responsibilities of the Programming Task Force will be further defined in the Programming Task Force Rules of Procedure, once adopted.
